Os bid for Bridge two

LEYTON ORIENT have made a five-figure bid—probably about £12,000—for two transfer-listed Chelsea players, Barking-born goalkeeper John Dunn and right-winger Joe Fascione. They have sent their offer in writing and are now waiting to hear from Chelsea. Dunne was regular reserve choice last season and Fascione a member of the first team squad at Stamford Bridge.

If manager Dave Sexton fails to get Dunn expect him to try again for Coventry's Vic Rouse—the keeper he chased unsuccessfully last term.
